WORKING TEST REGULATIONS/DEFINITIONS

PUPPY	Less than 18 months of age on day of Test
SPECIAL PUPPY (Unclassified)	From 18 to 24 months of age on day of Test
NOVICE DOG /NOVICE HANDLER (Unclassified)	Neither dog nor handler to have won any award including C of M at a Field Trial, or 1st, 2nd, 3rd or Reserve in any Open or all aged Working Test, or 1st in any Working Test.
JUNIOR HANDLER (Unclassified)	Open to dogs of any standard but restricted to the handler being 17 or under (on the day of the test).
NOVICE	Any dog or bitch of any age not having won: a) A Place or C of M at a Field Trial b) 1st, 2nd, 3rd in any Open Working Test c) 1st in Novice Test 1st in Puppy stake or 1st in Novice Dog/ Novice Handler is discounted for this purpose
INTERMEDIATE (Unclassified)	Any dog or bitch not having won: a) 1 st in intermediate, Open or All Aged Test b) 1st, 2nd, 3rd in any Field Trial except for NDNH Field Trial where 1st would be excluded
VETERAN (Unclassified)	Open to all dogs 8 years or older on day before the test.
OPEN	Open to all URC members. Preference in any draw will be given to dogs of members which have qualifications, and which make them ineligible to run in any other category of Test. Preference in the draw will be given to host area members.
NOVICE & OPEN WALK UP	Rules/Definitions as Novice and Open above

Tests run in conjunction with Training Classes or to assess ability or progress of dog or handler and specifically designed as such do not count as a disqualification for recognition in URC events.

Entries: All entries to reach the Working Test Secretary: Ms Sue Leeson, 81 Church Road, Christian Malford SN15 4BW by the closing date, enclosing a SAE for the draw or their e-mail and any other information. Tests open to URC members only. In the case of joint owned dogs all

owners must be Club members. A members' dog may be handled by a non-member. PLEASE NOTE: Handlers to run not more than 2 dogs in any one Test

PLEASE NOTE:

When a competitor is running two dogs in any working test, the committee has decided that officials and helpers on the day will be instructed not to agree to look after any dog during the competition. It is the handlers' responsibility to arrange a 'carer' for the dog not under the judge's direction.

Please do not ask any official or helper to look after a dog.

LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED
